#### Facts:

- The Block and Bridle club at LSU is an animal science and service organization.
- The first Block and Bridle Rodeo at LSU was held in the late 1920s.
- The Block and Bridle Club donates a percentage of their profits from the rodeo to Cancer Services of Baton Rouge.
  - Cancer Services is a non-profit organization that serves children who have battled cancer or who have loved ones battling cancer.
  - Cancer Services is a local organization based out of Baton Rouge but serves 10 surrounding parishes
     (Ascension, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, St. James, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana Parishes).
- The Block and Bridle Club will also donate a percentage to the Ag Career Closet, which was previously put on by the late Ashley Grant.
- The rest of the profits from rodeo benefit the advancement of the Block and Bridle Club. Such money will support our travels to National Block and Bridle Convention, our Little International Livestock Show, our end of the year banquet, and increase the production of next year's rodeo, etc.
